



## INTERNATIONAL ROYAL BLEĐ PRO AM, 11. – 14. JUNE 2026

### TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

#### 1. ELIGIBILITY

##### PROFESSIONALS

The Royal Bled Pro-Am is open to all PGA Members and recognized trainees, as certified by their respective National PGAs. Any disputes regarding eligibility will be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision is final.

##### AMATEURS

Amateur participants must hold a valid official handicap index and be at least 18 years old. Eligibility concerns will be decided by the Tournament Committee, and its decision is final.

#### 2. REGISTRATIONS

##### PROFESSIONALS

The Championship Office will be open from 10:00 on Thursday, 11 June 2026, at the Royal Bled Pro Shop. Professionals are encouraged to assist their team's amateur players with registration to ensure accurate handicap data is submitted.

##### AMATEURS

The Team Registration Office will also open at 10:00 on Thursday, 11 June 2026, at the Royal Bled Pro Shop.

All amateurs must confirm and present their current and official handicap index at registration.

## **4. CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

### **Professionals Individual Stroke play**

The Professionals will play a 36-hole individual Stroke Play event. Each Professional will play 18 holes on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June and 18 holes on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2026. The event shall be played under the R&A Rules of Golf and the local rules.

Male Professionals will be playing from the Black Tees; Female Professionals will be playing from the Blue Tees.

### **INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONALS STROKEPLAY PRIZE FUND BREAKDOWN**

Every Professional with valid score will get 500 EUR.

Additionally payouts for PGA Professionals will be as follow:

1<sup>st</sup> Place 3.000,00 EUR  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place 2.000,00 EUR  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place 1.000,00 EUR

In the case of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Individual Professional Stroke play, a play-off will take place on hole number 10 until a result is achieved. In case of a tie for other places, the prize will split between the winners.

The amount of the prize represents gross value. Preferably it is expected from the winner to issue an invoice for prize received. If not, organizer Eligo Bled d.o.o. will pay for the winners possible advance payment of personal income tax for the prizes received, in accordance with the regulations in force. Other possible tax liabilities or any other costs related to the prize lies with the winner. The recipient of the prize will receive a prize, provided that the organizer received his personal data (name, surname, address of permanent residence), Personal registration number, Bank account details and tax number. The payment of the prize to non-residents of the Republic of Slovenia will be made on the basis of the International Agreement on the Avoidance of Double Taxation of Income concluded between the Republic of Slovenia and the country of residence of the recipient of the prize.

### **Royal Bled Pro-Am**

Up to 23 teams (consisting of 1 Professional and up to 3 Amateurs) will compete in a 36-Hole Stableford event (without slope), with the best two Stableford scores from the team up to four players to count on each hole. Each team will play 18 holes on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June and 18 holes on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2026. The Pro-Am shall be played under the R&A Rules of Golf and local rules.

Male Amateurs will be playing from the White Tees; Female Amateurs will be playing from the Red Tees. 80 % h.i. before SR, max H.I. 20 will be allocated to amateur players with higher h.i.

Three overall team prizes (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>) will be awarded after accumulating the scores of the two rounds.

In the case of a tie in the Pro-Am, prizes will be determined by the last 18,9,6,3, 1 holes or lot.

### **Individual Amateur awards for Day 2 of competition:**

Nearest to the pin amateurs.

## **5. DRAWS**

### **Royal Bled Pro-Am**

The draw for Round 1 of the Royal Bled Pro-Am tournament will be published in the Tournament Office after 18.00hrs on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2026; Draw for Round 2 will be determined by results of Round 1 – the team with leading Professional will start the last.

## **6. RULES & ETIQUETTE**

### **Starting Times**

All competitors are required to be at their starting tee 10 minutes prior to their start time. This is to allow the starter to provide pin positions, local rules and additional information to each player. This also ensures that all team members are present and able to start on time.

NOTE: When either Professional or the team are subject to a two-stroke penalty for lateness on the tee, the team total for the first hole will be adjusted by two shots prior to any penalty being added to the score for that hole.

### **Order of Play**

All groups must play strictly in the order of play as determined and published by the Tournament Committee. No group is permitted to skip another group or alter the assigned order of play. Any change to the order of play is permitted only with the approval of the Tournament Committee in the following circumstances:

for verified medical or health-related reasons affecting a player or group, or in the event of a withdrawal or disqualification of a group, or other reasons considered by Tournament Committee.

Any unauthorized change to the order of play may result in penalties in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by The R&A Rules Limited, including but not limited to disqualification.

### **Buggies, caddies**

All competitors will be permitted to ride in buggies or appoint caddies for the practice rounds and both rounds of the Pro-Am.

### **Recording of Scores**

All scorecards for rounds 1, 2 must be returned by the Professional to the recording area situated within the Tournament Office immediately after the play.

### **Rulings & Doubt as to Procedure**

There will be R&A Rules Officials on the course at all times to deal with any disputes. If, however, there is no Rules Official present the player may invoke Rule 20.1c (3) - (two ball rule). The player must nominate the ball with which he wants to score, should the rules permit, and report the facts to Tournament Committee immediately after the conclusion of play. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

### **Distance Measuring Devices**

All competitors will be permitted to use distance-measuring devices provided they measure distance only. If a player has any doubt as to whether a device is conforming, they should seek the advice of a R&A Rules.

### **Slow Play**

For everyone's enjoyment we ask for each team to "keep up with the team in front, and not in front of the team behind". If a player is not going to score on a hole, he/she is requested to please "pick up".

A pace of play will be in place for the duration of the tournament. This will be detailed on the scorecard. It will be the professional's responsibility to ensure that the team's pace of play adheres to the guidelines of the Chief R&A Rules Official.

#### **Bad Weather / Play Foreshortened or Cancelled**

In the event of bad weather and an overall result not being possible, the overall result will be decided over completed rounds.

#### **Dress Regulations**

Normal Golf clothing is to be worn at Royal Bled during the tournament or the equivalent after golf.

On 11<sup>th</sup> June at welcoming cocktail and team auction a Smart Casual without blue jeans dress code is required.

On 12<sup>th</sup> June at dinner a Smart Casual dress code is required.

On 13<sup>th</sup> June at Royal Bled Restaurant 9 Gala dinner a Smart Casual + Jacket without blue jeans dress code is required.

#### **Mobile Phones**

Apart of emergency, mobile phones are **NOT** permitted on the golf course and Restaurant 9 under any circumstances. They should be used with discretion elsewhere.
